

Solutions to MCQs – Based on Current Affairs (7 July 2025)

Q1. With reference to the *National Biobank* launched under the Phenome India initiative, consider the following statements:

- 1. It collects genomic and clinical data from over 1 lakh individuals annually.
- 2. It is modeled on the UK Biobank but customised for India's genetic diversity.
- 3. It will support development of indigenous CRISPR therapies in India.

Which of the statements given above are correct?

- A. 1 and 2 only
- **B.** 2 and 3 only
- C. 1 and 3 only
- **D.** 1, 2 and 3

Answer: B - 2 and 3 only

Explanation:

- Statement 1 is incorrect: The Biobank aims to collect data from 10,000 individuals, not 1 lakh.
- Statement 2 is correct: It is **inspired by the UK Biobank** but reflects India's ethnic and lifestyle diversity.
- Statement 3 is correct: It will help develop low-cost CRISPR-based gene therapies.

Q2. Which of the following correctly distinguishes Pressurised Heavy Water Reactors (PHWRs) from other reactor types?

- A. They use enriched uranium as fuel and heavy water as coolant.
- **B.** They use natural uranium and require frequent shutdown for refuelling.
- **C.** They allow online refuelling and use heavy water as both moderator and coolant.
- **D.** They are based on thorium breeding cycle and use molten salt as coolant.

Answer: C – They allow online refuelling and use heavy water as both moderator and coolant

Explanation:

• C is correct: PHWRs use **natural uranium** and **heavy water** (D_2O) as both coolant and moderator. They allow **online refuelling**, reducing downtime.



- X A is incorrect: PHWRs do not use enriched uranium.
- X B is incorrect: No frequent shutdown is needed due to online refuelling.
- X D is incorrect: Thorium-molten salt reactors are part of **Gen-IV concepts**, not PHWRs.

Q3. Nipah virus can be transmitted through which of the following routes?

- 1. Eating fruits contaminated by bat saliva
- 2. Consuming pasteurised cow's milk
- 3. Direct exposure to body fluids of infected persons
- 4. Airborne aerosol transmission over long distances

Select the correct answer using the code below:

- **A.** 1, 3 and 4 only
- **B.** 1 and 3 only
- **C.** 2 and 4 only
- **D.** 1, 2 and 3 only

Answer: B – 1 and 3 only

Explanation:

- 1 & 3 are correct: Virus spreads through bat-contaminated fruits and human fluids.
- X 2 is incorrect: No evidence suggests pasteurised milk transmits the virus.
- X 4 is incorrect: No airborne long-distance transmission (unlike influenza).

Q4. Regarding the *International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture*, consider the following:

- 1. It legally binds signatory countries to share all plant germplasm through bilateral agreements.
- 2. It recognizes and protects Farmers' Rights including seed saving and exchange.
- 3. It is associated with the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) and Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD).

Which of the statements is/are correct?

A. 2 and 3 only



B. 1 and 2 only

C. 1 and 3 only

Answer: A - 2 and 3 only

Explanation:

- X Statement 1 is incorrect: The treaty uses a Multilateral System (MLS), not bilateral sharing.
- Statement 2 is correct: Farmers' rights (Art. 9) are protected—seed saving, exchange, and recognition of traditional knowledge.
- Statement 3 is correct: Linked to FAO and CBD.

Q5. Consider the following pairs regarding the ancient city Penico:

- 1. Located in coastal Colombia
- 2. Known for ceremonial architecture and trade hub role
- 3. Contemporary to Egypt and Sumerian Bronze Age

Which of the pairs are correctly matched?

Answer: B - 2 and 3 only

Explanation:

- X 1 is incorrect: Penico is in **Peru**, not Colombia.
- 2 is correct: Excavations revealed ceremonial temples and central trade activity.
- 3 is correct: It dates to ~1800–1500 BCE—parallel to early Bronze Age.

Q6. In the context of the 17th BRICS Summit, which of the following statements is/are correct?

1. Indonesia became the first Southeast Asian country to join BRICS.



- 2. The summit was held in Rio de Janeiro and adopted a declaration promoting reforms in WTO and IMF.
- 3. BRICS originally started as a formal international treaty signed in 2001 by five countries.

- X 3 is incorrect: BRICS began as **informal dialogue in 2009**, not as a formal treaty.

Answer: D – 1, 2 and 3

Explanation:

- 2: Flows through **Île-de-France**, including **Paris**.
- 3: Empties into English Channel at Normandy.

- 1: MLS covers 64 key food and forage crops.
