Q1. Answer: B

- Exercise Amogh Fury is an **Integrated Fire Power Exercise** carried out by the **Sapta Shakti Command of the Indian Army**.
- Aim: To validate combat preparedness, demonstrate coordination between arms, and integrate firepower in realistic operational settings.
- Source: IT

Q2. Answer: C - Both 1 and 2

- Statement 1: Correct First 10-year trend report (2013-14 to 2022-23) covering all 28 States.
- Statement 2: Correct Punjab had the highest Debt-to-GSDP ratio at 40.35% in 2022-23.

Q3. Answer: B – Only two

- Estonia shares land borders with Russia (east) and Latvia (south).
- Lithuania does not share a land border.

Q4. Answer: D

- Poompuhar, also called Kaveripattinam, was an ancient Chola port city at the mouth of the Kaveri River in Tamil Nadu.
- Served as a second capital and major trade hub.

- Statement 1: Correct High Seas Treaty is legally binding under UNCLOS.
- X Statement 2: Incorrect It is the third implementing agreement, not the first.
- Statement 3: Correct India signed in September 2024 but has not yet ratified.

Q6. Answer: A - 1 and 2 only

- Statement 1: Correct Instituted in **1969** to honour contribution to Indian cinema.
- Statement 2: Correct Presented annually with **Swarna Kamal medallion, shawl, and cash prize**.
- X Statement 3: Incorrect First recipient was **Devika Rani**, not Satyajit Ray.

Q7. Answer: D - Neither 1 nor 2

- X Statement 1: Incorrect Developed with support from **Asian Development Bank (ADB)**, not World Bank.
- X Statement 2: Incorrect Covers **all industrial parks nationwide**, not only SEZs or metropolitan areas.

Q8. Answer: C - Both 1 and 2

- Statement 1: Correct National Supercomputing Mission (NSM) launched in 2015 by **DST** and **MeitY**.
- Statement 2: Correct India's fastest supercomputer is **AIRAWAT-PSAI at C-DAC, Pune**; ranked in top 100 globally.

- Baltic Sea coastline shared by Sweden, Poland, Lithuania, Finland, Germany, Denmark (also Latvia, Estonia, Russia).
- Total coastline approx. 8,000 km.

- Project Vijayak aims to provide road connectivity and upgrade strategic infrastructure in Kargil and Zanskar regions of Ladakh.
